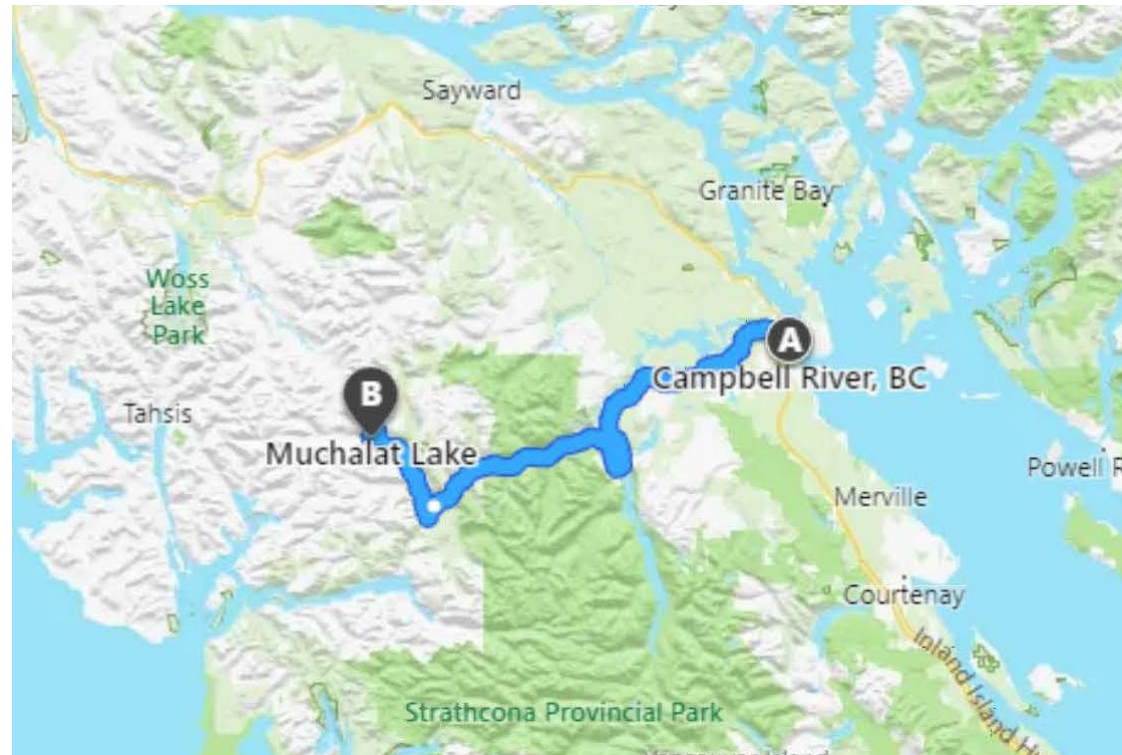

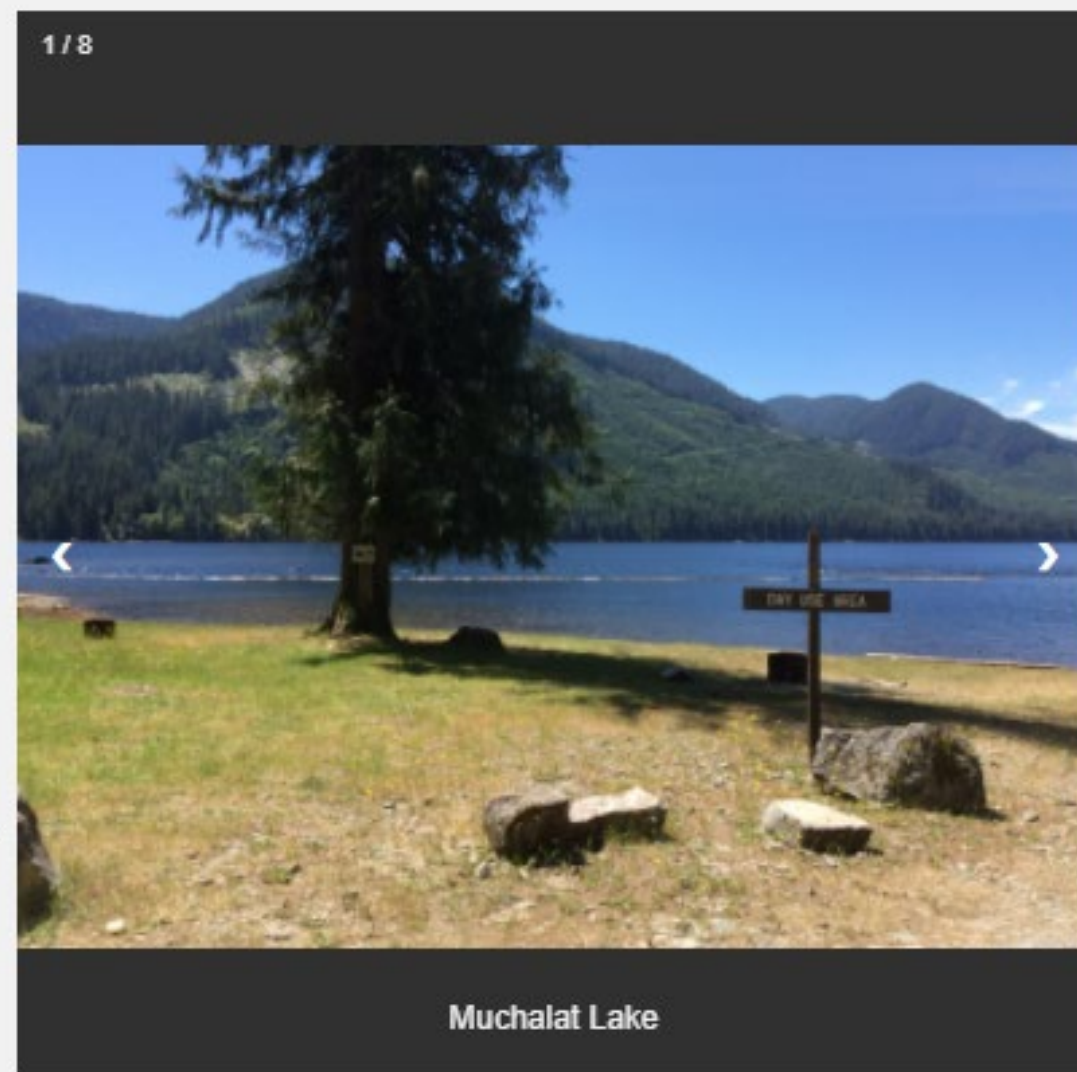
# Muchalat Lake (Gold River)

- **Site Description:** A large, treed site at the east end of Muchalat Lake. Site includes a boat ramp, dock, beach and swimming area; lots to see and do! Muchalat Lake will remain open for public use during the off-season.
- **Driving Directions:** As you approach the Village of Gold River via Hwy 28, head straight through the junction (don't turn left into town). After crossing the river, you'll come to a T-junction. Turn right (head north) and follow the signs to Muchalat Lake Recreation Site. About 12 km from the T-junction (mostly gravel road); 20 minutes.





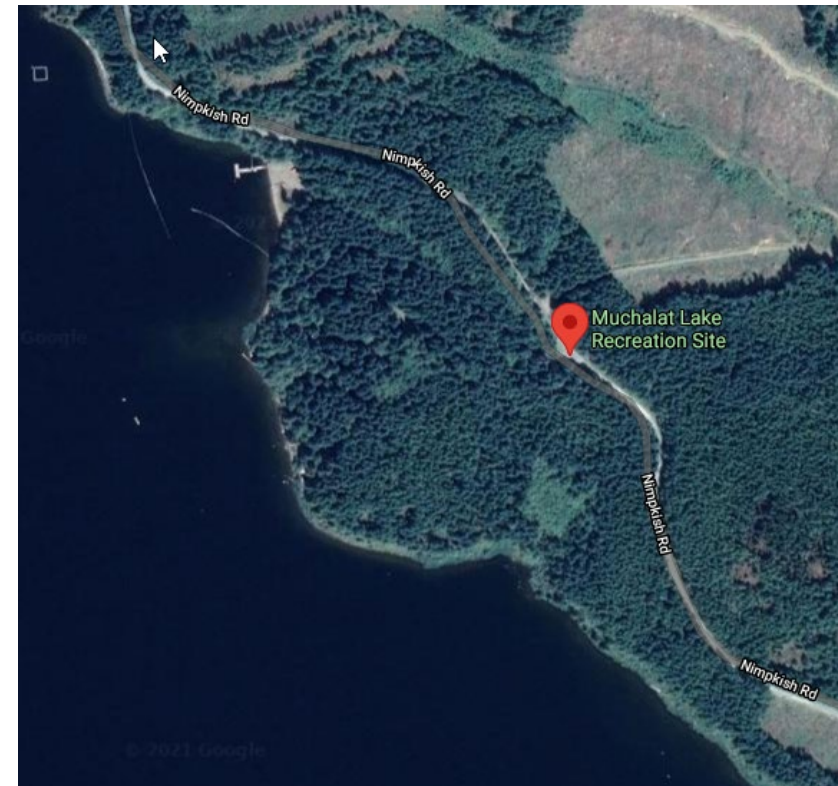

# Muchalat Lake Recreation Site

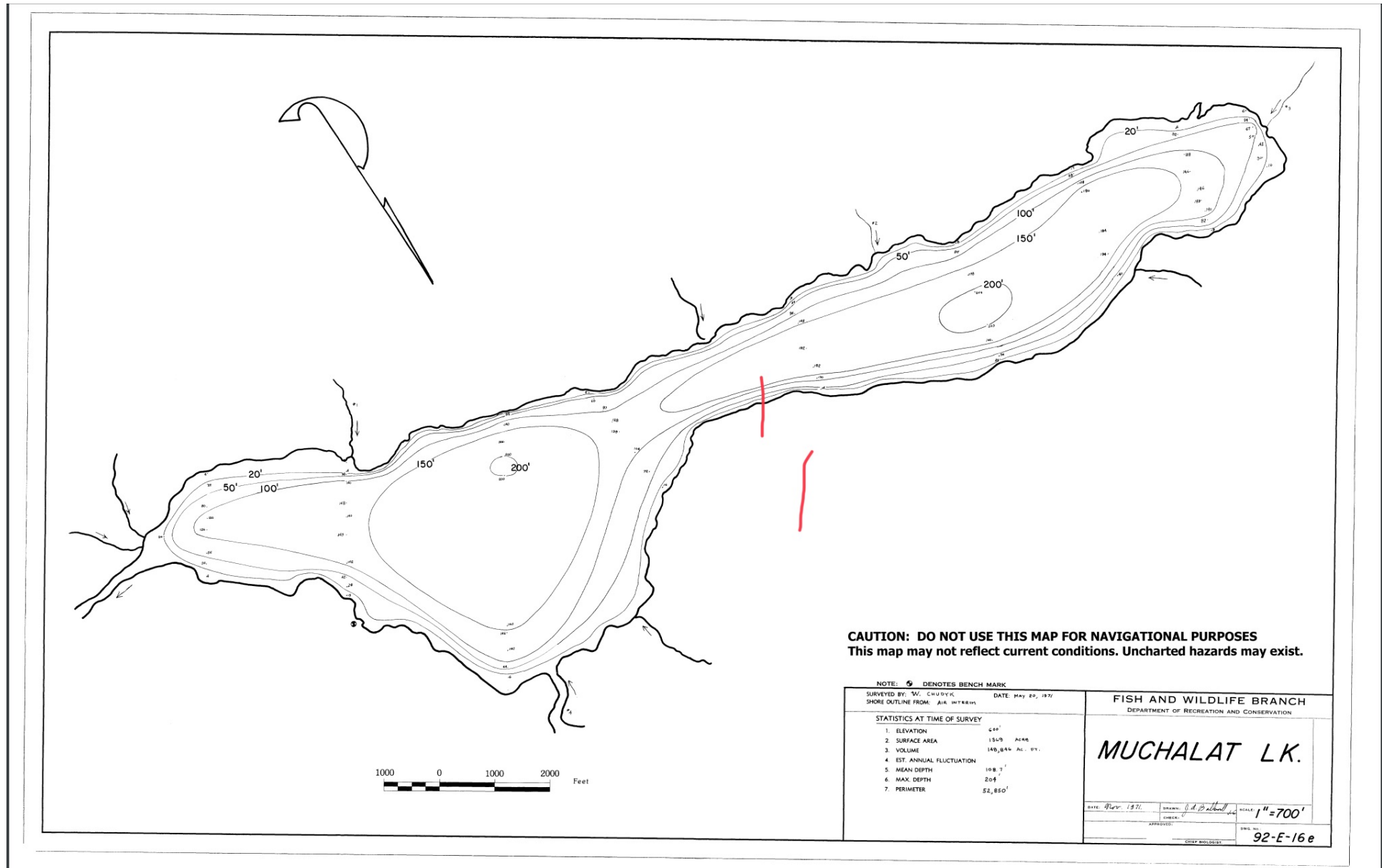


This is a first come first serve campground. Visit the camp host upon arrival and check the [bcparks.ca](http://bcparks.ca) website for more details.
